

CALL FOR ARTISTS/ON-FILE APPLICATION

TO DISPLAY WORK AT The Eau Claire Regional Arts Center Gallery

FOR YOUR INFORMATION

- Work cannot be older than five years old and not have been exhibited in the ECRAC gallery in the past two years.
- All work must go through the jury process and must be of professional quality.
- All pieces must be clean and ready for display or they will not be hung or placed. Two-dimensional pieces must be wall-ready and hung with wires. Saw-tooth hangers are unacceptable.
- Artists should include a resume (no formal art training or exhibition record required) and an artist statement.
- Artwork to be juried can either be six slides of professional quality representing the medium and direction of pieces to be shown placed in a plastic sleeve, or CD/DVD as jpegs or PowerPoint formats. Jpegs should be 300 dpi and include a file with names, media, size, and years made of each work. Please label jpegs as follows: last name_title_slide number.jpg (ie jones_tree_01.jpg). PowerPoint slides should be labeled with the above information. Your name must be on the slide, along with title, year made, and dimensions. Place a red dot on the lower left corner of traditional slide with slide number. Please list which direction is up. Detail photos of work may be included but do not constitute one of the six works.
- Send a stamped, self-addressed return envelope so we may return your slides.
- All work must be for sale. ECRAC's commission on sale of artwork is 30 percent for Regional Arts Center members and 40 percent for non-members.
- If possible, you will be expected to help hang the show.
